Parent Volunteer Essential Agreement

In line with PYP practice we are introducing this 'Parent Volunteer Essential Agreement'. An essential agreement is an understanding between all parties to make the role of a parent volunteer more clear.

As a Parent Volunteer you agree to:

- Support teachers to maintain routines. Helping children to open and eat their snacks, pack their school bags and move around the kindergarten safely.
- Encourage independence.
- Speak to the children to help develop their language and communication skills. At Wu Kai Sha we celebrate all languages but have a main emphasis on learning English.
- Encourage children to be risk takers and try new things. Children learn by example so come and be a risk taker yourself!
- Be flexible
- Support teachers during outings. We may occasionally call on you to support us during small outings.
- Maintain confidentiality for all children. We need you to respect the rights of others, just as we protect your child's rights.
- Follow directions from teaching staff who may need extra support in areas of the classroom or Self Selected Learning areas, and to remain in those designated areas.
- Discuss concerns you may have with either the class teacher or the Principal.
- Help ALL children in the Kindergarten.
