What's it all about?

- Opportunity to participate in the life of the kindergarten
- Good opportunity to support children in their learning in the kindergarten setting
- You can help with a wide variety of activities
- Parent volunteers will be supervised by the class teacher

Responsibilities

- Interacting, talking, listening with all children.
- Supporting routine times, including; transitions, assisting children to look after their environment throughout the day and to tidy-up at the end of the session.
- Encouraging children to remember the safety aspects and particular rules.
- Supporting group activities.

Talking and Listening to Children



- Chatting in English social exchanges are very important for developing children's language acquisition and thinking skills.
- For the purpose of developing children's ability to describe in their own words what they have seen; made; touched; felt; heard; imagined; discovered; solved.

Questioning Techniques

• I wonder what will happen if...

• What do you think happens when...

• I wonder why that happened...

• Tell me about this.....



Managing Behaviour

- Recognise poor behaviour disrupt play and learning of others or damage self esteem.
- Intervene and hear both sides.
- Encourage children to empathise and solve the problem themselves with support.
- Offer alternative choices rather than punishments. "Play with that spade safely or do you need to play somewhere else?"
- Phrase things positively eg: 'Walking Feet' instead of 'Don't Run'

Supporting Activities

• Scaffold.



- Remember each child is an individual ability, creativity and preferences.
- Process not product.
- Model skills where appropriate.
- Don't do it for them ! Develop independence and creativity.

How it works

Important Points To Note

- Try and arrive early for explanation.
- You are in school to support **all** children in the class.
- Confidentiality vital Talk to class teacher or the Principal if you have concerns about a child or an activity you have seen.
- No answering phones in school please.
- Please don't take photos whilst you are here to help.
